SELCERT: Skills Development and certification for trainers of synchronous electronic learning

What is SELCERT about?

An Erasmus+ project that aims at developing a qualification framework for trainers that deliver Synchronous Electronic Learning.

Online training also known as computer-based training, synchronous electronic learning, distance learning or e-learning is a form of instruction that takes place through the use of ICT and the internet. These few past years have revealed many benefits of electronic learning in terms of time saving and accessibility.

The SELCERT project aims at enhancing quality electronic learning. Quality e-learning requires special training skills. These skills are created and supported by SELCERT through a qualification (ISO certified) for trainers that deliver Synchronous Electronic Learning accompanied with training materials and tool, as well as a certification.

In order to achieve this quality enhancement, SELCERT produced the following results:

- A qualification framework for trainers that analyze, design, develop, implement and evaluate online trainings
- Curricula, materials and digital methodological tools to train the web trainers
- A digital assessment tool
- A digital resource centre networking tool
- A multimedia guide on how to adapt different techniques on different platforms
- A best practice guide for the delivery of online learning

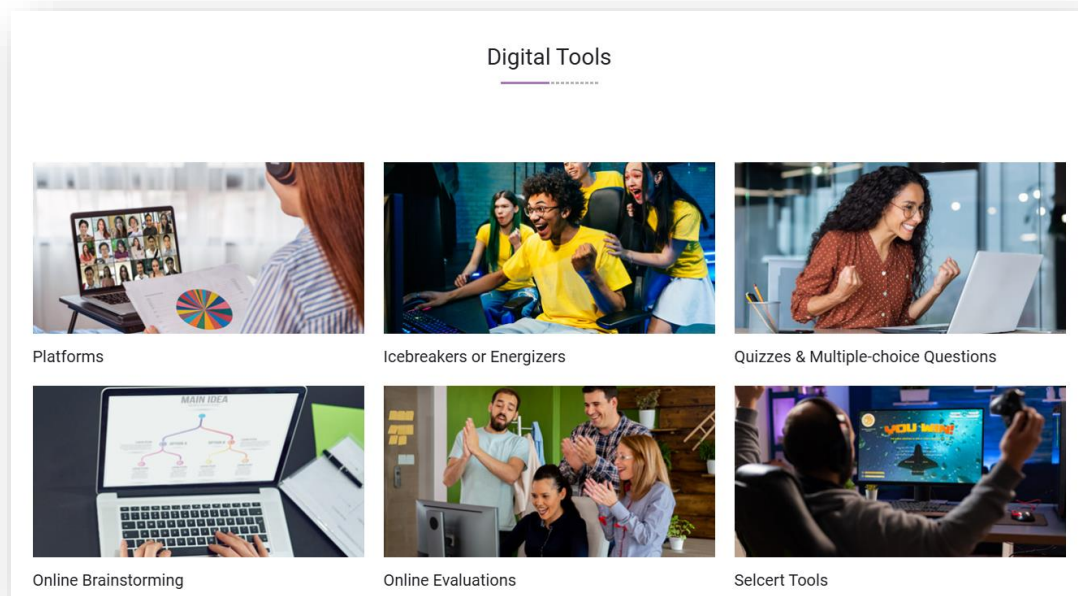
Project Result 6: Digital resource center and networking tool for synchronous electronic learning (SEL) trainers

There are different tools for assisting in the delivery of synchronous online training organized under categories.

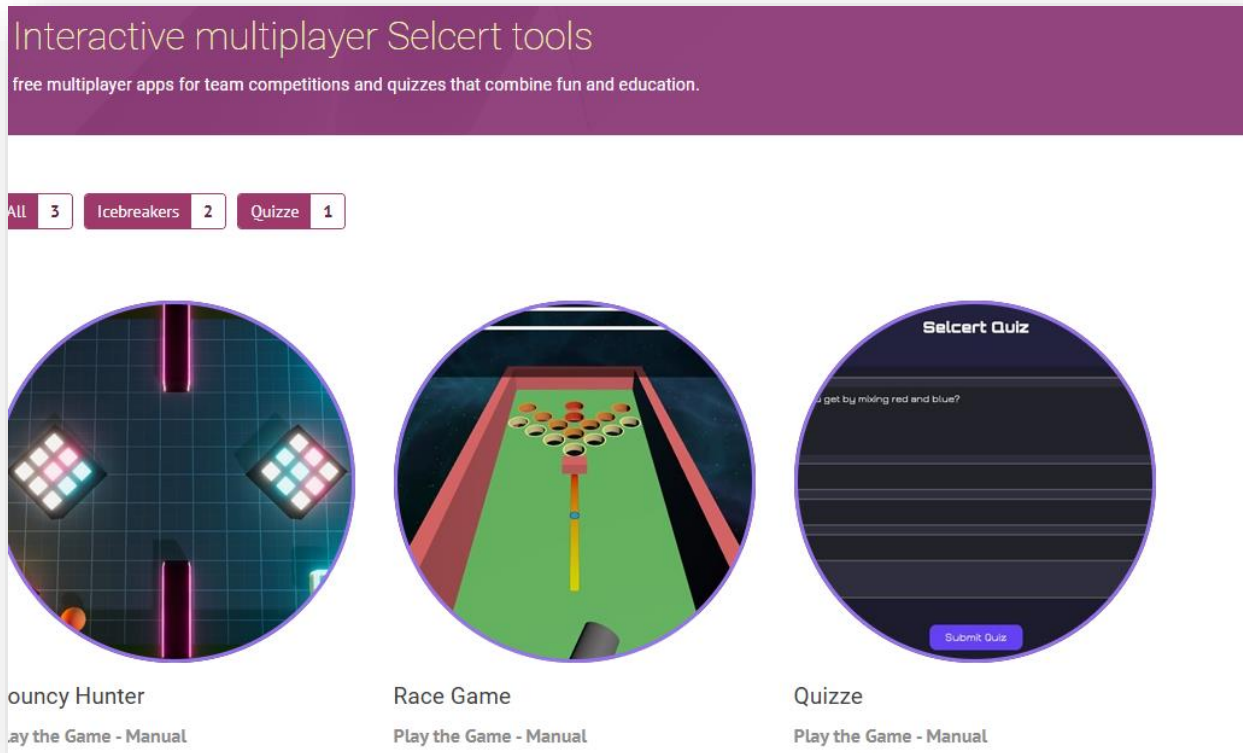


There also tags for filtering the proposed tools under each category. There is a detailed description for each tool with links and video tutorials.

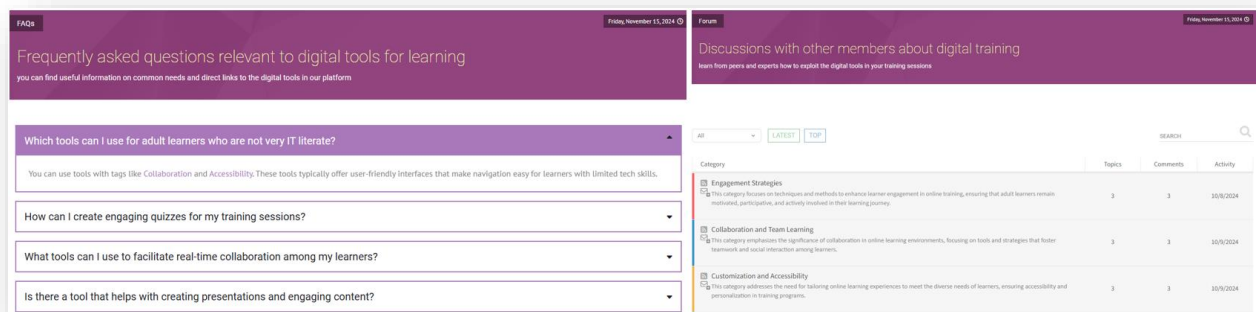
